Sermon Title: It Really is a Supernatural Life

Scripture text(s): Galatians 5: 22-23

1) In what ways do you leave room for God to work? How have you seen this kind of patience at work in your life? Discuss the ways God has worked.

2) Richard used 1 Timothy 1:16 to remind us of God's unlimited patience in relation to our sin. How does this bring encouragement to your heart but also challenge you to follow hard after Him?

3) Richard defined kindness as demonstrated compassion. Discuss ways you have received this and how it encouraged you to demonstrate compassion.

4) Richard said that sympathy becomes active and that the opposite of kindness is heartless indifference. Discuss the difference between these and the results of each.

5) Richard specifically mentioned showing kindness to a prodigal. Think of someone you know who is a prodigal. With that person in mind, in what ways can you begin to show kindness in order to draw them to the Lord?

6) In what ways does the world teach that we are good? What does the Bible say about our "goodness"?

7) Richard said that goodness is a pulsating desire to do right because it reflects who God is and what God loves. What do you need for this to be true in your life?

8) How have you experienced God's goodness and how can you demonstrate His goodness to the world?
