Even Toddlers and Preschoolers can begin studying the Christmas story by meditating on and memorizing, “Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you. He is Christ our Lord”
paraphrase of Luke 2:11

“I CAN DO THAT, MAYBE EVEN A LITTLE MORE”

If memorizing scripture is a new adventure for you, or maybe your children are younger elementary ages... set this goal for your family: Memorize Luke 2:9-12. Throughout the challenge you would have 2 weeks to learn each verse.

“I’M IN, GIVE ME MORE”

Your journey to memorize scripture may be a bit further along. Set a goal to learn Luke 2:8-20 as you make your way through the entire Shepherd’s account of the birth of Christ. This goal would be appropriate for Older Elementary and young students. In 8 weeks you will memorize 13 verses, focusing on 1-2 per week.

“I’M PRETTY EXPERIENCED WITH MEMORIZATION, WHAT CAN I DO?”

Over the next 8 weeks, commit to learning 2 verses per week in order to fully memorize Luke 2:4-20 as we prepare our hearts and homes for the biggest celebration of the year!
