- 6) After Jonah was thrown overboard the storm ceased. Richard said, "The wrath of God against the sailors was stopped." Because of Jesus, this is now true of us. How does this encourage you, spur you on, challenge you?
- 7) What will you do now that God's wrath has been turned from you? How can you be God's hands and feet for people still under God's wrath?
